AN UPDATE ON MEASURES BEING TAKEN TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 BY MERCHANT SHIPPING – No. 23 04.05.2020

Further updates on COVID-19 precautions have been received from members as summarized below. As always, please contact the relevant association for more guidance.

Cyprus	<p>Cyprus has announced a phased relaxation of its lockdown laws across a wide arrange of activities and those related to shipping and ports are as follows:</p> <p>Phase 1, 04 – 20.05:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hosting of cruise ships for refuelling (without disembarkation of passengers or replacement of crews).• Replacement of crews for merchant ships and the movement of private boats in licensed areas, for purposes of mooring, maintenance and repairs. <p>Phase 2, 21.05 – 08.06:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ports in full operation (from June 1), with the exception of the disembarkation of passengers from cruise ships. <p>Phase 3, 09.06 – 13.07:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Airports / Airlines - gradually and conditionally.• Ports, service and cruise ships.
