| Denmark | The right of seafarers to shore leave has been reinstated today, 15 th July. |
| Dubai | <p>Dubai Maritime City Authority has advised that crew change in Dubai ports and anchorages is allowed subject to compliance with the Dubai Health Authority COVID-19 guidelines and scheduled flights in UAE.</p> <p>All agents are required to coordinate with “The General Directorate of Residency and Foreigners Affairs”, Dubai Ports & Airports, and make sure the quick process of crew transfer from ships to airports and from airport to ships. All agents and employers are requested to adhere with COVID-19 tests and guidelines issued by Dubai Health Authority to maintain the health of crew and employees.</p> |
