## AN UPDATE ON MEASURES BEING TAKEN TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 BY MERCHANT SHIPPING – No. 74 02.11.2020

Further updates on COVID-19 precautions have been received from members as summarized below. As always, please contact the relevant association for more guidance.

<b>Denmark</b>	<p>With certain specified exceptions (see below) all travelers arriving in Denmark from high risk countries (see the list at <a href="https://um.dk/da/rejse-og-ophold/rejse-til-udlandet/rejsevejledninger/">https://um.dk/da/rejse-og-ophold/rejse-til-udlandet/rejsevejledninger/</a> - only in Danish) must present a certificate confirming that a COVID-19 test has been taken and passed no more than 72 hours prior to arrival.</p> <p>Seafarers have been deemed essential workers and so a test certificate is not required for either arrival from, or departure to, any country (including those deemed as high risk) for the purposes of effecting crew changes. Any seafarer demonstrating symptoms of COVID-19 on arrival will however be prevented from entering the country.</p> <p>Please note however that shore leave is currently restricted to seafarers who do have a COVID-free certificate issued in the preceding 72 hours.</p>
