Sayın Üyemiz,

Uluslararası Deniz Ticaret Odası (International Chamber of Shipping- ICS) tarafından gönderilen 2 Ocak 2021 tarih ve ICS(21)07 sayılı ekte sunulan yazıda;

**Gemi Sahipleri, Gemi İnsanları ve İdareler için Kapsamlı Deniz Güvenliği Rehberi'nin** ilk baskısının yayımlandığı, söz konusu yayının 2021 yılı Nisan ayında satışa sunulması ile birlikte, Deniz Güvenliği: Gemi İşletmecileri için Uluslararası Denizcilik Örgütü (IMO) Uluslararası Gemi ve Liman Tesisleri Güvenliği Kodu (ISPS) Rehberi (2003) ile Model Gemi Güvenlik Planı (2003) yayınlarının satıştan kaldırıldığı belirtilmektedir.

Yazıda, Denizde Can Emniyeti Uluslararası Sözleşmesi (SOLAS) ve ISPS Kodunun güvenlik için özel bir yasal çerçeve oluşturmasından bu zamana kadar geçen sürede konunun daha iyi anlaşılması ve risk ve tehditlerin azaltılması için en iyi uygulamalara imkan tanıyan yeni bir güvenlik kültürü ortaya çıktığı bildirilmektedir.

Yeni Rehberin, denizcilik sektörünün karşılaştığı tehditler ile geminin seferine yönelik kapsamlı bir tehdit değerlendirmesinin nasıl yapılacağına dair gemiler, gemi işletmecileri ve liman tesislerinin uyması gereken yasal sorumluluklar ile bir gemi güvenlik planı modeli içeren, özellikle gemi ve liman tesisi işletmecileri, gemi insanları, küresel ticaret güvenliği ilgilileri ve İdareler için faydalı bir rehber niteliği taşıdığı ifade edilmektedir. 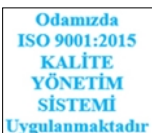

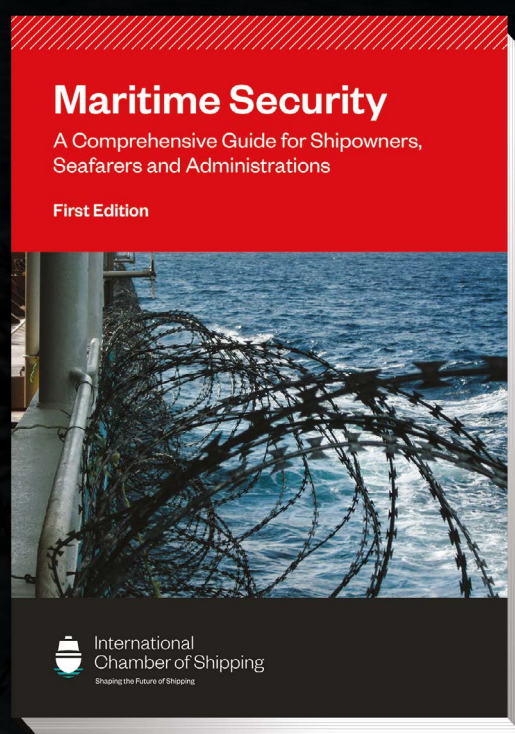
